New Transportation Bill – Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) Signed into Law

MAP-21 will provide \$106 billion in funding for surface transportation programs for fiscal years (FY) 2013 and 2014.

MAP-21 extends the current SAFETEA-LU programs and all related provisions through the end of FY 2012 which includes the 100% federal share for the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement Program, which was scheduled to expire at the end of FY 2012.
